PROGRAMS

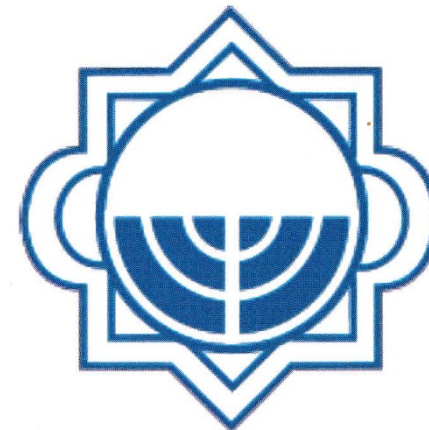

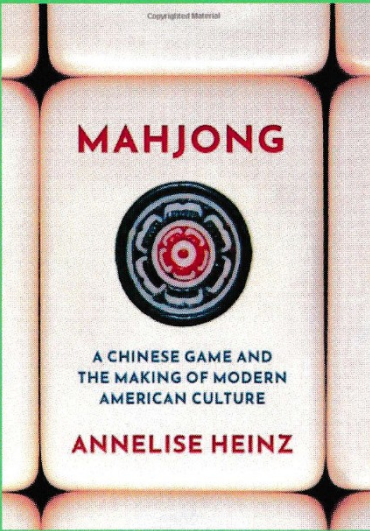
REINVENTING During the Pandemic
