Please bring in canned goods or other nonperishable food items to donate.


Adult Purim: February 28, 5:30pm

In 1970, Judy Blume published her well-known coming-of-age novel *Are You There God? It's Me, Margaret*. While the book is best known for its descriptions of puberty and early adolescence, it also portrays Margaret's experience as the child of an interfaith couple, including the spiritual tug-of-war between her Jewish and Christian



grandparents. In the decades that followed, many new stories have emerged about multifaith and multicultural families. Come explore what Margaret's grandparents and other fictional characters can teach us about the promise and the pitfalls of building our own multifaith and multicultural families.
